## TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS AVAILABLE

### **Young Executive I** (Full Participating Membership)

This membership encourages the next generation golfers and their families. Age range for Young Executive I is from 23-30. When the Young Executive reaches age 31, their membership would automatically move to Young Executive II. Monthly Dues \$120

### **Young Executive II** (Full Participating Membership)

This membership encourages the next generation golfers and their families. The age range for Young Executive II is from 31-40. When the Young Executive reaches age 41, they have the choice of moving to a "Full Participating Non Transferrable" or an "Individual Only" classification at the prevailing rate at the time of transfer. Monthly Dues \$150

**Individual Only** Entitles one individual to all of the amenities of Deep Springs Country Club for himself/herself. No other family members can use Deep Springs Country Club facilities without paying associated guest fees. Monthly Dues \$135
